### Main trends in KCSIE:

- Greater emphasis on mental health (now incorporated into the definition of safeguarding, para 4 – see also paras 34-38)
- Additional information on CSE and CCE in Part One (para 28) and updated entries in Annex A. New sections on children who need mental health support (paras 113-116) or a social worker (paras 109-112) – the latter triggering an additional point in the DSL role description (Annex B, raise awareness section). Also updated information on Domestic Abuse in Annex A; Honour Based Violence now referred to as Honour Based Abuse
- Further clarification on information sharing in a safeguarding context (paras 84-5) together with reference to a new data protection toolkit (para 86)
- Supply staff now incorporated into procedures for managing allegations against staff (paras 56 + 214-217) – and an extension of the conditions under which a referral to the DBS should be made (para 179 + 211)
